### Provisional timetable/idea of when times will be available

Eligibility for all classes can be found in the BRC Winter Champs 2024-25 Eligibility Criteria. [winter-champs-2025.pdf \(bhs.org.uk\)](#) or in the BRC 2025 Handbook. Eligibility will be taken from close of pre-entry & competitors must be a registered current member of the correct club on Sport80 by midday the Friday before the qualifier. Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.

This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below:

**SCHOOLING OVER FENCES IN THE 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN AND WILL BE PENALISED. ANY COMPETITOR FOUND TO HAVE SCHOOLED AT THE VENUE IN THE 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION WILL INCUR 20 PENALTIES ADDED TO THEIR SCORE. FURTHER, IF THEY ARE A TEAM MEMBER, THE TEAM WILL BE GIVEN AN ADDITIONAL 20 PENALTIES. THIS IS AN AREA 6 RULE ADDITIONAL TO THE BRC RULES.**

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC (fees and entry dates can be found in the current BRC Handbook) at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge if space permits. **Late entries cannot be guaranteed and so therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.** There will be no return of pre-entry fees however a credit note may be issued at the discretion of BRC providing the request is sent in before the close of pre-entry.

Once the pre-entry has been made, an area entry must be made to the organising club. We are happy to accept the entry on an email but please ensure that you state class, rider, horse name, membership number and whether they are team or individual.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason and rescheduled within 21 days, the close of pre-entry will remain. If the qualifier is rescheduled for more than 21 days after the original date, entries will re-open. Late entry fees will not be refunded. Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, regardless of rescheduling. Pre-entries that cannot attend the new date may be issued a credit note but the Team Manager must inform the office in writing before the cut-off date which the area will be informed of upon rescheduling.

### **Hats**

All hats must have a visible pink BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn on the showground to show that they meet the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. **FIXED PEAK HATS ARE NOT ALLOWED FOR THIS COMPETITION.** For up-to-date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

### **Body Protectors**

A body protector is obligatory in all cross-country competitions – this should be Beta level 3 blue label 2018.

Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

### **Flu Vaccinations & Microchips**

- Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website. If you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. As of 1 October 2020, it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.
- Last vaccinations must be within 12 months but not during the week preceding the show.
- **Team Managers are responsible for ensuring that vaccinations are valid and up to date.**
- **Passports should travel with horses and there may be spot checks on the day.**
